



The **Peace Treaty Pageant** packs 300 years of history into two hours, commemorating the **Great Peace Council of 1867** between the US Government and the five Plains Tribes: **Apache, Arapaho, Cheyenne, Comanche, and Kiowa.**

The re-enactment takes place in the **Gyp Hills** featuring a **natural amphitheater** near the actual site of the council where the Medicine River and Elm Creek flow together.

The weekend festivities include a **Pow Wow in the Indian Village**, Traders and Crafters, Parades, Craft Show, a Carnival, and more.

At night, venture back to 1884 at the **Historical Melodrama** of the Medicine Valley Bank Robbery. Can-can girls and the gun slinging cowboys will make you believe that you are back in time with their song and dance. A true legend, Carry Nation makes her appearance at the Red Dog Saloon to rid it of its evil liquor .

Medicine Lodge is also home to the **Kansas Championship Ranch Rodeo** and its Cowboy Trappings and Trade Show held the last weekend of September each year.

While in town, visit the Historic **Stockade Museum.**
