

The Peace Treaty Pageant packs 300 years of history into two hours, commemorating the Great Peace Council of 1867 between the US Government and the five Plains Tribes: Apache, Arapaho, Cheyenne, Comanche, and Kiowa.


The re-enactment takes place in the **Gyp Hills** featuring a **natural amphitheater** near
the actual site of the council where the
Medicine River and Elm Creek flow
together.


The weekend festivities include a **Pow Wow in the Indian Village**, Traders and
Crafters, Parades, Craft Show, a Carnival,
and more.

At night, venture back to 1884 at the **Historical Melodrama** of the Medicine Valley Bank Robbery. Can-can girls and the gun slinging cowboys will make you believe that you are back in time with their song and dance. A true legend, Carry Nation makes her appearance at the Red Dog Saloon to rid it of its evil liquor.

Medicine Lodge is also home to the Kansas Championship Ranch Rodeo and its Cowboy Trappings and Trade Show held the last weekend of September each year.
